Mastering InfoVista® Server Report Design

Duration: 3 days

VistaFoundation® Centralized Inventory (VF-CI) is InfoVista's adaptive technology platform for service-centric IT performance reporting. This course is intended for students that have already taken the 2.x or 4.x 'VistaFoundation Solution Development' course and would like to learn more about the powerful reporting capabilities of the InfoVista Server. This course will focus strictly on content development at the server level. This course will examine content that could be used in VistaMart® / VistaPortal® as well as content that would only be available through drilldowns. Both types of content will be clearly notated so the student knows what content would be available where.

Student Profile

Students should be very familiar with the workflow for developing content in a VF-CI environment. This course is for those users that are already very comfortable with the Solution Development materials and would like to learn more about advanced InfoVista Server reporting options available to them. This course is most helpful to those with very specific reporting requirements.
